A **free job training program** for individuals experiencing homelessness and seeking a start in a real career

This 4-week training program is funded by an Environmental Workforce Development Job Training Grant awarded to the Arkansas Construction Education Foundation by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

Who is eligible? Candidates must:

- Must be 18 years or older.
- Have a high school diploma, GED or enrolled in a GED program.
- Be physically able to perform demands of work, including wearing respirator.
- Have access to transportation to training center.
- Be currently homeless, unemployed or underemployed

- OSHA Hazardous Waste Operations
- Asbestos Worker Skills
- Your Role in the Green Environment
- OSHA 10-Hour Safety Course
- Introduction to Brownfields Program
- Awareness of Green Supervision Practices
- Underground Storage Tank Leak Prevention
